SHORE LEAVE & STAY OVERS

If your guests only have a few hours spare between connections or departures, we can provide tours that keep them occupied rather than waiting around in terminals.

Most of our private tours are available with a pickup/drop-off from the main transport hubs such as Schiphol airport, Amsterdam PT, IJmuiden, Central Station and even Rotterdam. These tours can range from a couple of hours exploring the city to a full day tour discover towns outside of Amsterdam. Depending on the size of the group, your guests would be met by our driver guide, or for groups larger than 8, a driver and a guide.

TRANSFERS

We can also arrange transfers for your guests, to and from the main transport hubs. For groups of 8 and under, your guests will be met at the arrivals gate with a named sign, and escorted to their Mercedes class vehicle. For groups larger than 8, we use a company that has a range of different size minibuses and coaches. Whatever the destination, our transfer team will ensure your guests arrive safely, and when departures are involved, in plenty of time so they do not miss their connection. Prices by request.

ALKMAAR & EDAM, THE CHEESE CITIES

The tour starts at your hotel, where your guide will meet you with your vehicle and take a short drive north of Amsterdam to the historic cheese cities of Alkmaar and Edam. Depending what day and time of year you book, it may be possible to visit one of the cheese markets in the cities.

ALKMAAR

The first stop of the day is Alkmaar, often described as 'Holland in miniature'. As you explore this medieval city centre you will quickly discover it has a timeless charm with its narrow cobbled streets and beautiful bridges crossing over the canals. It

Alkmaar is also home to the oldest cheese market in the Netherlands, which has taken place on the main square for centuries. This market runs every Friday from the end of March to the end of September, and should you be visiting the city on a Friday, our guide will happily show you this traditional event. The square also has the traditional weighing house and a cheese museum which you can visit.

EDAM

The afternoon will be spent in the second cheese city of the of the day. Famous for it's round cheeses, the centre of Edam has a variety of historical buildings, including a warehouse with a floating basement. Close by is Fort Edam which forms part of the Dutch Waterlines defence system. Edam also has a famous cheese market, and should you take this tour on a Wednesday between July & August, we can visit colourful cheese market.

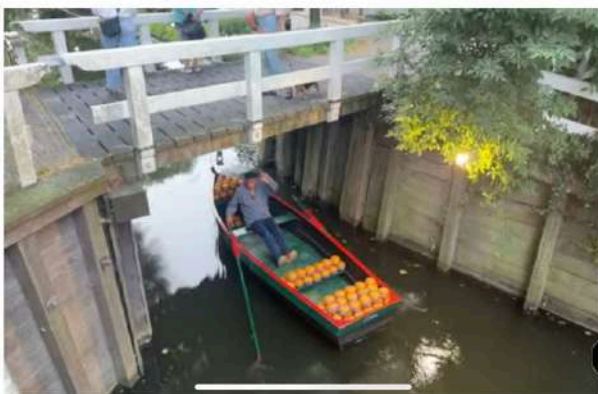

KEUKENHOF & FLOWER FARMS TOUR

Period: March 20th until May 11th 2025

Feel the tulip fever and surround yourself with millions of colourful flowers on our Private Keukenhof tour. Visit a flower farm next to the endless flower fields.

The 'kitchen garden' of Keukenhof delights millions of visitors every year with its spectacular collection of tulips displayed in its gardens and pavilions. Within Keukenhof, you will find an amazing collection of tulips, daffodils, hyacinths, irises, orchids, and many other flowers and plants too, in an overwhelming rainbow of colours and varieties.

SUMMER FLOWER GARDENS

Period: May 12th until mid August 2025

This tour will take you on a journey of discovery to find a variety of flowers that are in full bloom during this period. Roses, hydrangeas, sunflowers, lilies, orchids and many more flowers fill gardens at this time. There are a variety of gardens to choose from, including stately castle gardens, to traditional rose gardens and even botanic gardens, particularly handy when the weather isn't so nice.

KEUKENHOF CASTLE & DAHLIAS

Period: August 7th until mid October 2025

At Keukenhof Castle, you will be able to enjoy over 100 different varieties of Dahlia showcased in their Dahlia Days festival. There's time for you to explore the extensive castle grounds before travelling to the nearby Tulperij dahlia show gardens.

The show garden has more than 600 types of dahlia and you can even even pick your own bunch of flowers to take away with you. Throughout the tour there will be plenty of opportunities to take photographs.

WINTER TULIPS AT PRONK TULIPS EXPERIENCE

Period: mid October until mid March 2026

Now you don't have to wait until Spring to experience our glorious tulip tours. Thanks to our partners at Pronk Tulips Experience, we can offer you a touch of colour in even the darkest of winter days. No need to worry about the weather either, as this experience is indoors so everyone will stay warm and dry.

This tour visits an indoor tulip grower who has flowers from October right through to March. You'll experience the full process required to grow tulips indoors, and even have the opportunity to pick some tulips to take away with you.

CANAL DISTRICT, DAM SQUARE, JORDAAN AND MORE

One of the charms of Amsterdam is the 'open-air' museum feeling and there is a lot for you to explore. We will show you the older parts of the city centre visiting the heart of the city at the famous **Dam Square** and the first two man-made canals. As you explore the famous **Canal Belt** you'll walk along streets lined with the famous **canal houses** that lean in all directions.

AMSTEL RIVER & CANAL DISTRICT

We will stroll through the quaint streets of the 17th-century **canal district**, crossing several picturesque bridges and seeing the houses of rich merchants and traders. Just west of the canal district is the old working-class area called **Jordaan**, where you will see the house **Anne Frank** and her family hid in for over 2 years.

ANNE FRANK & JEWISH HISTORY

Travel back in time with us to the Amsterdam of WWII where Anne Frank and her family were in hiding and visit the Anne Frank House (Free entrance tickets included!) Learn about Amsterdam's rich Jewish history by passing landmarks of the Jewish quarter. Feel the emotion and hope of Anne Frank during the dark days of the war. Join us inside the famous Anne Frank House through the bookshelf to the secret hiding place of the family Frank.

We start in front of the Jewish Historical Museum and from there we will pass the old Portuguese Synagogue, WWII memorials, an old theatre, and several other buildings on some of Amsterdam's 17th-century canals. We can then walk or take a 15-minute tram to the western part of Amsterdam to see the Western Church and the statue of Anne Frank. This walking tour ends at the Anne Frank house with your entrance ticket. You will have the opportunity to visit the museum by yourself at your own pace.

ANNE FRANK & JEWISH HISTORY - IN PICTURES



Duration: 2 hours (including 30 minutes VR experience)

This tour will start at the small statue at Max Euweplein, close to Leidseplein. It will finish at a cafe, Spanjer en van Twist, close to the Anne Frank House.

ANNE FRANK'S LAST WALK

Anne Frank is Amsterdam's most famous resident. Every year millions of people travel to Amsterdam to see where Anne and her family hid from the Nazis during WWII. In this tour, we will walk along the last 600m of the route Anne and her family took on their journey to their hiding place, and sadly their final home. Together, we will travel back in time and experience the emotion and hope of Anne Frank during the dark days of the war as her story unfolds.

PRINSENGRACHT & WESTERKERK

As we walk around the local area we'll see the famous Westerkerk, the outside of the house where Anne and her family were hiding for over 2 years and the beautiful Prinsengracht. Using Anne's own words from her diary, we will learn about Anne and the 'secret annex', Rather than a sombre story of loss and sorrow, this tour is also about tolerance and hope, because, as Anne wrote: "Don't think of all the misery, but of all the beauty that still remains."

ANNE FRANK HOUSE IN VIRTUAL REALITY

We will finish our tour at a cafe near **Anne Frank House**. Here you will have a drink and then enter the Secret Annex via the magic of a virtual reality recreation (designed by the Anne Frank Foundation). As you enter virtually through the famous bookshelf to the secret hiding place of the family Frank you will find the rooms as though the Franks were still living there. Unlike the actual house, the virtual house has all of the furniture and belongings in place, giving you a true feel for what it was like to live there in 1942-44. We believe this is as close to the real thing as you can get, without stepping foot in the house.

APENHEUL MONKEY SANCTUARY

A visit to Apenheul is a day you will never forget. Many of the monkeys roam freely around the site, allowing for up-close encounters and plenty of opportunities for the perfect wildlife photograph.

Apenheul is a 12-hectare forest in the middle of the Veluwe. You will discover around 300 monkeys in amongst the greenery. About half of these monkeys run loose in the park. In the new pygmy monkey area, you will find free-roaming pygmy monkeys, such as the [red titi](#), white-faced saki and a [silver oistiti](#). The [squirrel monkeys](#) are very curious and jump on the tunnel through which you as a visitor walk. A day of monkey spotting is not only special but also instructive. Of all animals, monkeys are the most similar to humans. During your visit, you will not only learn more about the monkeys but also about yourself. Do you have smart orangutan traits? Are you as energetic as a squirrel monkey? You may even recognise yourself in one of the more than [35 monkey species](#) in Apenheul.

This unique monkey park continues to surprise you. Climb and clamber like a monkey in one of the many [playgrounds](#), walk past the largest insect hotel in the world, visit the presentations of the animal caretakers, participate in unique [activities](#) and watch gorillajong Kiango grow up. Moreover, you take the most beautiful [animal photos](#) here.

Of course, there are also monkeys in Apenheul that do not roam free, such as gorillas and orangutans. They do not live in cages or behind bars, but on large, natural islands. This way you can see the monkeys at their best.

The older part of Amsterdam is a colourful and very diverse area and deserves more attention than the colour of the lights and how one can get to higher levels. The artisan breweries, the way the oldest church has always managed to keep up with the changing times. On this tour we will explore the history of this famous neighbourhood where the criminal underworld and the upper world are intertwined in full harmony.

The red light district is also home to many residents who live regular lives. Due to the city regulations, and general respect for privacy, it is not permitted to take tours into the actual red light area. However, this tour will take you as close as we can get and explain how this community thrives. Our guides can show you where locals shop for groceries, have their kids cared for and the old folks home where you can imagine hearing the most colourful memories of this area.

ARNHEM, NIJMEGEN & WWII

On this tour, you will uncover the incredible World War II stories relating to Operation Market Garden and the infamous 'bridge too far' in Arnhem.

Your tour starts at your hotel, where your guide will meet with a vehicle and then take you north to the city of Nijmegen, one of the oldest cities in the Netherlands. Being close to the German border, this was the first Dutch city to be occupied by German forces during the war. As you walk through the streets, your guide will share stories of the city's wartime experiences, including the accidental bombing by American planes and the intense battles fought during Operation Market Garden.

Next, you'll drive to Arnhem, renowned for the daring attempt to secure a crucial bridge, famously depicted as 'a bridge too far'. You will have an opportunity to explore this strategic location and learn about the bravery of the soldiers who fought there and the important role it played in the allies' battle to secure a route through enemy territory.

The Airborne Museum at Oosterbeek has an extensive collection of artefacts and exhibits related to Operation Market Garden, giving you further insights into the operation's complexities and impact. Continuing your journey, you will have a chance to pay your respects at the Canadian War Cemetery in Groesbeek, where rows of white gravestones stand as solemn reminders of the sacrifices made during the war. There are several other museums in the area that you may wish to visit, such as the Liberation Museum or the War Museum in Overloon, where interactive displays and informative exhibits offer a deeper understanding of wartime experiences. Your guide will be happy to discuss the various options with you.

The indoor museum has a variety of exhibits including a ship hall with thirteen real ships that sailed on the Zuiderzee. There are also traditional costumes, paintings and utensils on display from the Zuiderzee area. The Outdoor Museum is divided into five different zones. At the centre is a village, recreating many aspects of villages around the Zuiderzee. Many of the buildings in the different neighbourhoods also come from the village or city that they represent.

THE HANSEATIC TOWNS

Our guide will meet you at your hotel and together you will drive northeast of Amsterdam towards the cluster of towns that were part of the Hanseatic trading league during the 14th & 15th centuries. In total there are nine of these medieval towns in the area, and we have selected our top five for you to choose from. On this tour you will have the opportunity to visit three of the towns mentioned below:

HARDERWIJK

[Harderwijk](#) is a beautiful, historic Hanseatic city located on the edge of Hoge Veluwe National Park and Veluwemeer. There is plenty to see and do as the historical town has 100 national monuments and the entire old town has been declared a protected monument. The town even has a beach on the banks of Wolderwijd, which is quite unusual this far inland. Where fishing boats from the Zuiderzee used to moor, it is now a place for feeling the wind in your hair on the sandy beach or strolling along the boulevard.

HASSELT

To the north of Zwolle, on the Zwarte Water, is the Hanseatic city of Hasselt. A town full of character with leafy streets, interesting buildings and hidden spaces. Hasselt is known as 'Little Amsterdam' and when you see the canals, bridges, quays and locks in the small city centre, it's easy to see why. Some of the canals even have familiar names, such as Heerengracht and Prinsengracht.

Hasselt is a town of pilgrimage. Going back to medieval times, this Hanseatic town was an important religious centre. Pilgrims still find their way to Hasselt today, with two routes converging: the Jabikspaad from Friesland and the Jacobspaad from Groningen.

KAMPEN

Kampen is located on one of the most beautiful river fronts in the Netherlands. Almost 500 monuments are evidence of the important role this town played in the past as part of the Hanseatic League.

A stroll through the town will take you down hidden courtyards, along the historic city gates, and discovering colourful Art Nouveau buildings. Sometimes you can even see the reconstructed Kogge ships on the waterfront as they set sail.

HATTEM

Hattem is located on the river IJssel and with its uninterrupted view of the famous endless Dutch skies, was a location where many painters found their inspiration.

As a Hanseatic city, Hattem flourished in the Middle Ages and this wealth is still visible as you walk around the old town centre and see the impressive merchant's homes. Hattem is over 800 years old and has several historical monuments including the Roman-style foundations that were laid in the 13th century. Parts of the original defence system are still in place and the fourteenth-century Dijkpoort, part of the city walls, can be visited. fourteenth-century

ZWOLLE

Zwolle is not just a Hanseatic city but also a university town. It is the largest of the Hanseatic towns in The Netherlands. The star-shaped canal and fortification around the old city are well worth investigating, as is the Sassenpoort, the only historical city gate remaining.

The medieval centre of Zwolle has an eclectic collection of shops and restaurants, including a Michelin-star eatery and trendy bars. Waanders in de Broeren, a very impressive bookshop, is located in a church. Another must in Zwolle is the Zwols Balletjeshuis. This sweetshop has been going strong for centuries and still offers an amazing assortment of traditional and delicious confectionery.

CASTLE MUIDERSLOT

In the morning, we visit one of the oldest, intact castles in the Netherlands. Built in 1285, its strategic location at the end of the Vecht river made it an ideal place to raise taxes for any boats passing by. Visitors get the opportunity to see the hidden treasures of the castle. There is also more to discover in the castle's courtyards. On top of that, the castle pays special attention to the unique relationship the castle has had with the city of Amsterdam. And like all places in this country, the ever-lasting fight with water also plays a central role in the castle's history.

NAARDEN

You will also visit the fortress town of Naarden, which still has its double-walled star fortifications in place. The city is one of the best-preserved fortified towns in Europe. Naarden was one of the most important defence works of the New Dutch Waterline and is breathtaking. Naarden is an example of a Spanish star fort with fortified walls and a moat. As you stroll through Naarden you'll find more historical buildings and monuments, such as the St. Vitus Church, a large gothic basilica from the 14th and 15th centuries.

DE HAAR

De Haar Castle is the largest castle in Holland and is located just outside Utrecht. De Haar has everything you expect from a castle; towers, turrets, moats, gates and suspension bridges. The castle is also home to many art objects. Next to the castle, you can find a romantic chapel and beautiful parks and gardens.

Castle De Haar may look Medieval but was actually built in the early twentieth century. The famous Dutch architect Pierre Cuypers built it between 1892 and 1912 on the ruins of the old, derelict castle that stood there. In the '60s, it became a place where the family received the international jet set, from Brigitte Bardot and Coco Chanel to Maria Callas and Roger Moore.

PALACE HET LOO

Paleis Het Loo was the summer residence of stadholders, kings and queens for three centuries. William III had Het Loo Palace built on the Crown Domain Het Loo as far back as 1685. Like the other European monarchs, he wished to impress his visitors and show them how rich and distinguished he was. William and his wife, the English princess Mary Stuart, were lovers of architecture and landscape design. So when they ascended the English throne in 1689, they had splendid gardens with pavilions built that were worthy of their new status and were comparable to the gardens of their French rival at Versailles.

ROYAL HISTORY IN THE PALACE

The palace remained in the hands of the Dutch royal family, and after World War II, Queen Wilhelmina decided to spend her dotage at Het Loo Palace. After her abdication in 1948, she retired to the palace and died there in 1962. The castle has been open to the public since 1984, after extensive renovations.

During the tour, you will be able to explore 2 wings of the palace, the East, where William and Mary resided, and the West, home to Wilhelmina. You can also visit the palace roof and have an amazing view of the gardens below.

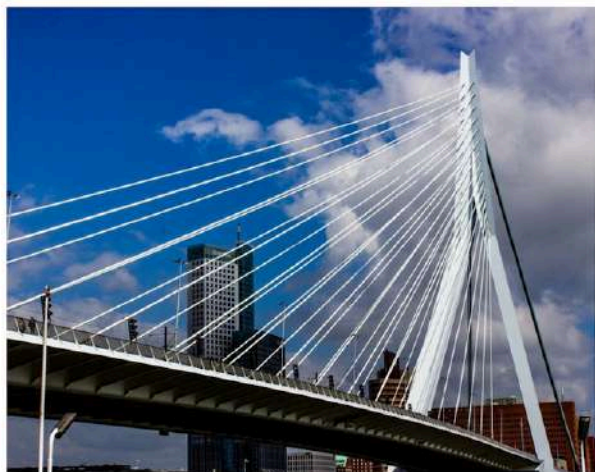

The Stedelijk aims to offer unique and compelling insights into today's world and highlight topics that impact our societies and individual lives with their collection, exhibitions and publications.

The permanent collection alone contains almost 700 pieces, presented around historical movements, social themes and influential artists. The collection contains pieces from the late 19th century to pieces from the present day. The temporary collections change regularly and these collections can be anything and everything. Previous exhibitions contained pieces of Jean Tinguely, Amsterdamse School, Keith Haring and Carlos Amorales.

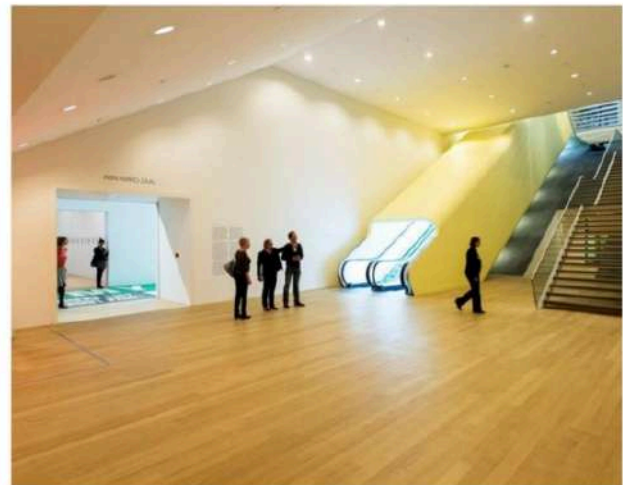

You will discover a picturesque harbour area complete with delightful swing bridges, a buzzing market square and quaint cobbled streets. Your guide will tell you some of the history of the area as you explore together. Then it's back into the car to drive back to Amsterdam. WESTERBORK & WORLD WAR II

Known by many during World War II as 'the gateway to hell' Westerbork was a transit camp for tens of thousands of Jews, Roma, Sinti and many others who were deported from there to death camps like Auschwitz and Sobibor

In this tour, you will visit the sobering site of the Netherlands' main concentration camp, a two-hour drive from Amsterdam. In this isolated spot, 102,000 people were held and then transported east, towards almost certain death in the gas chambers and work camps.

Your guide will take you around the extensive site, which still has several of the original features in place. You will see for example the commander's house, one of the barracks and even part of the train track that brought and carried away so many people to the Nazi extermination camps in Poland and Germany.

The site contains several very moving memorials to those who passed through the camp only to be brutally murdered by the Nazi regime, at other locations. Our guide will explain the historical background of Westerbork and share some of the stories of the many souls who passed through it.
